 - about twenty miles north of the old purchase line in the County of  
 Northumberland within the last purchase made of the Indians contain-  
 -ing eleven hundred and seventeen acres and twenty four perches  
 with the usual allowance of six per cent for roads &c. surveyed for Tim-  
 -othy Pickering Samuel Hodgdon Duncan Ingraham Junr and Tench  
 Coxe the 3<sup>d</sup> day of June 1786 in pursuance of a warrant dated May 17<sup>th</sup>
