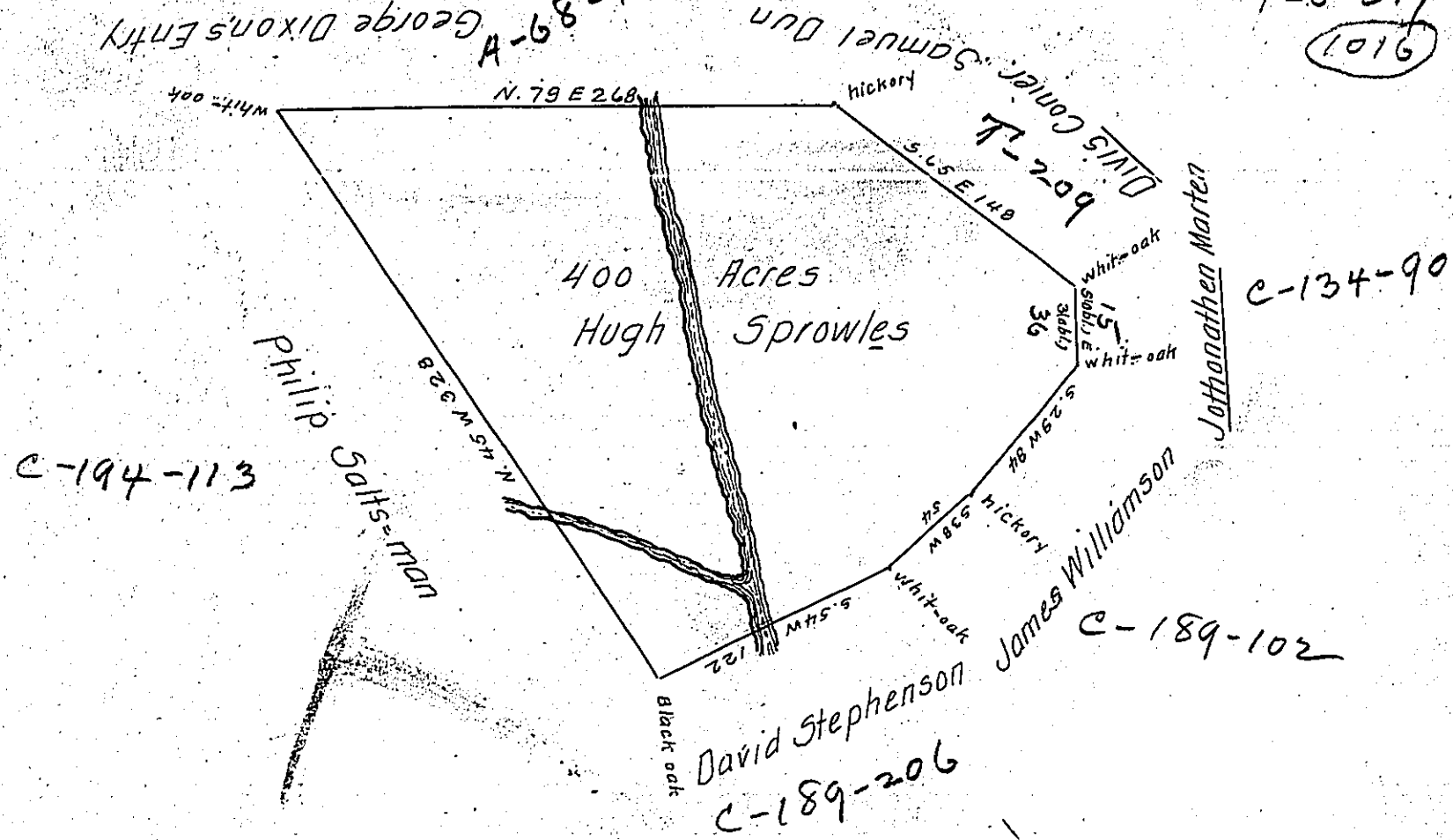

We the Commissioners for adjusting the Claims to unpatented land in the Counties of Monongalia, Yohogania and Ohio. do hereby certify that Hugh Sprowls Assignee of John Springer is intitled to four Hundred Acres of Land in the County of Yohogania Situate on the Waters of Millers run to include his Settlement made in the year 1773.

Given under our hands at Coxes fort the Eight Day of February 1780 and in the fourth year of the Commonwealth
