



Situated on the two Mile Run up Beaver River above Fort Mackintosh in District No. 1 in the Tract of Country appropriated by Act of the General Assembly of Pennsylvania for the Redemption of the Certificates of Depriciation &c and bounded on the East by that Line that Divides the Districts No. 1 and No. 2 & on the North by a Line running Due West from the Twelve Mile Post from the Northern Boundary of said Tract of Country & Surveyed in the Month of June 1785 Pursuant to Instructions Given by John Lukens Esq^r Surveyor General of the State of Pennsylvania dated the twenty fifth day of August 1783.
