



Situated on Two Mile Run a Branch of Beaver River that empties into Beaver on the West Side 2 Miles above Fort Mackintosh in District No. 1. being the 3^d Survey Westward of the Division Line of said District & No. 2. in the 1st Parallel South of the 3^d 4 Mile Square from the Northern boundary of that Tract of Country appropriated by Law for the Redemption of the Certificates of Depreciation &c. and Surveyed in the Month of June 1785 Pursuant to Instructions from John Lukens Esq. Surveyor General of the State of Pennsylvania.
