The above is the draught of a survey made March 11<sup>th</sup> 1795 in pursuance of a warrant granted to John Sproat on the 14<sup>th</sup> day of April 1792. Situate North west of the Ohio river on the Waters of Beaver Creek adjoining land granted to Joseph Spencer called Herwerden - containing 397 Acres & 4 perches - with the usual allowance of 6 p. Cent &c.
