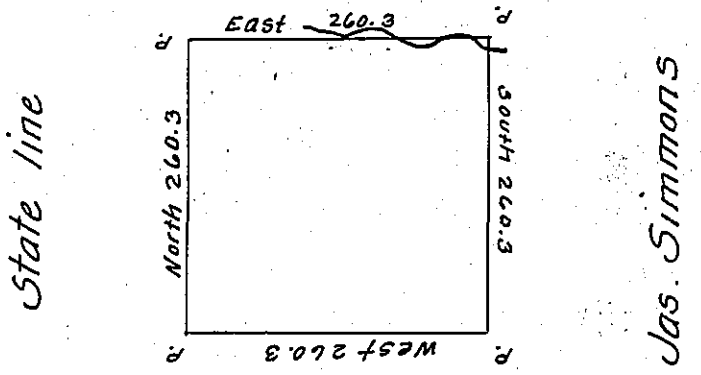

The above is the draught of a Survey made March 12<sup>th</sup> 1795 in pursuance of a Warrant granted to Joseph Skerret on the 14<sup>th</sup> day of April 1792. Situate North west of the Ohio river on the Waters of Beaver Creek - adjoining land granted to James Simmons - called Frisac containing 400 Acres with the usual allowance of 6 p. Cent &c.
