



Draught of a tract of land situate in Tyrone Township Perry County containing 100 acres 136 perches and allowance of six per Cent for roads No. 1 contains 87 acres 97 perches and allowance of six per Cent for roads being part of a tract of land surveyed April 7th 1767 in pursuance of a Warrant granted to Thomas Ross dated first of June 1762. No. 2 contains 13 acres 39 perches and allowance of six per Cent for roads being part of a tract of land surveyed October 15th 1784 in pursuance of a Warrant granted to Samuel Ross dated 23rd August 1784. Surveyed the above tract October 24th 1851 for patenting for George Shively
