



By virtue of an application dated the 30th day of October 1765. N^o 1173 the above described tract of Land situate at the back of the Tuscarora Mountain in Brunswick Township Berks County containing 219^a 92^p & allowance of 6. p. 6^t for roads &c^l called Beaver bottom, was surveyed to John Willets the 21st day of November 1766 by Mordecai Yarnal (who surveyed under John & Jasper Scull.)
