Originally surveyed December the 6<sup>th</sup> 1769 in pursuance of an Order granted to Israel Jacobs for 300<sup>a</sup> dated December the 27<sup>th</sup> 1766 No 2289. Surveyed as above for Alexander Branyan October the 8<sup>th</sup> 1829.
