We the Commissioners Appointed to Settle Titles and adjust Claims to unpatented Lands in the Counties of Monongalia Yohogania and Ohio do hereby certifie that Samuel Strain is Intitled to Two hundred and Fifty Acres of Land in the County of Yohogania on the Waters of Yohogania River to Include his Settlement made thereon in the year ~~of our~~ 1767 Given under our hands at Redstone Old Fort the 9<sup>th</sup> day February 1780 and in the fourth year of the Commonwealth
