The above Tract is a part of a Larger Tract of Land Surveyed by Thomas Arnot for Anthony Moul Dec^d all which proved to ^{be} the property of Andrew Hershey except the 42^a as in this Draught — after several searches in the Office I cannot yet be satisfied whether Anthony Moul had any Legal Right for the same — there was no Improvement of any kind on it when I executed M^cScott's Warrant — I have made this Note that if the Heirs of Anthony Moul have any prior Right, they may bring it forward.
