



Situate on the South side of Jones's Mill run, Including an Improvement first begun the first day of June 1806, Whereon George Robinson & family, ^{resided} from the time of the Improvement aforesaid until the time of making this Survey, In Addison Township Somerset County, and Surveyed the 16th day of March 1811 by John McClean Esquire late Deputy surveyor, In Pursuance of a Warrant dated the 15th day of February 1811, as appears by his Official Draught remaining in my Office at Somerset, And certified this 28th day of November 1816.
