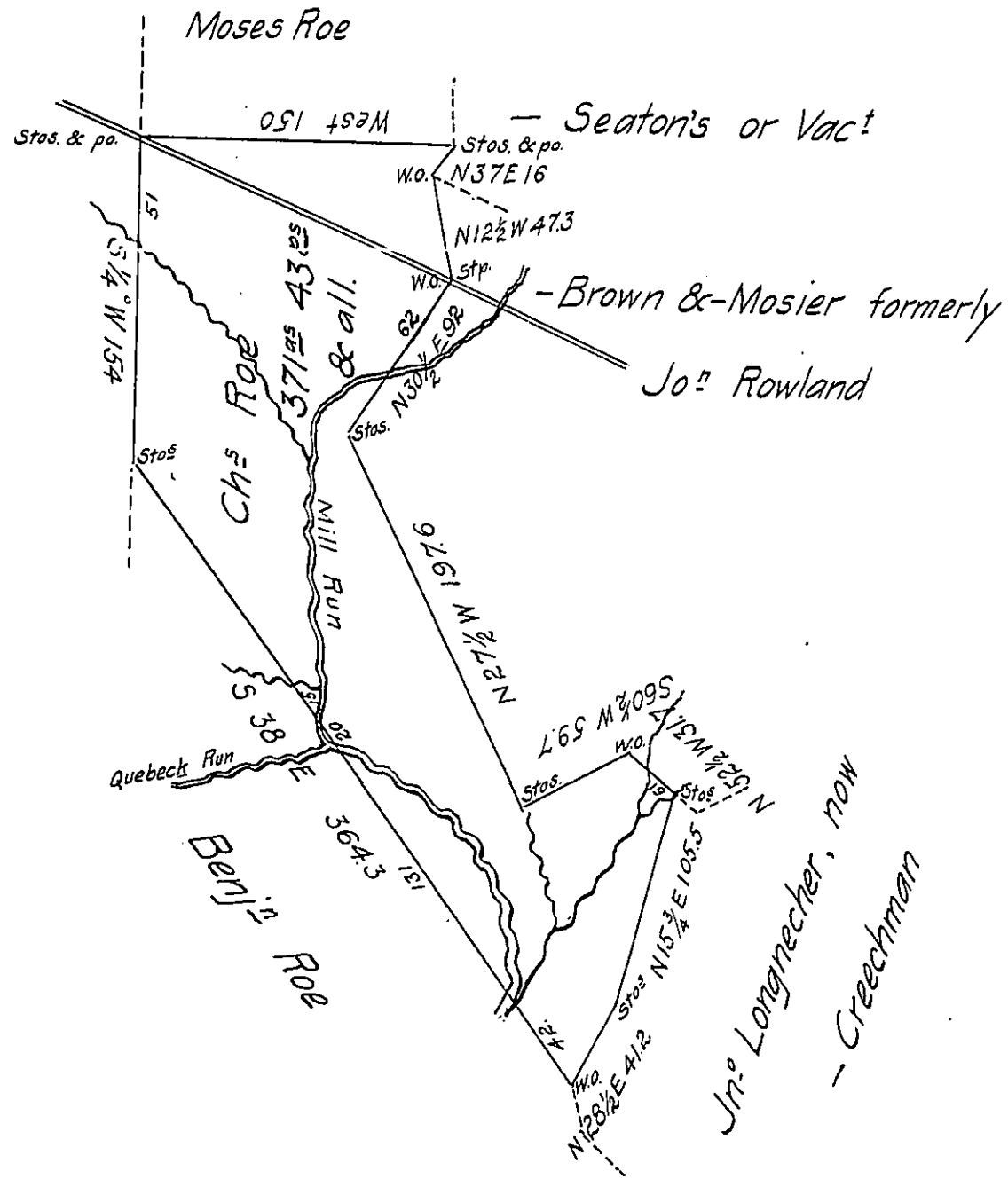


*The Ruston Surveys*



*Situate on Crosses Mill Run a Branch of Sandy Creek in Wharton township, Fayette County & Surveyed the 17<sup>th</sup> day of September 1835 In pursuance of a Warrant in the name of Charles Roe for 400<sup>ac</sup> dated the 5<sup>th</sup> day of February 1794. there is a dwelling house, a Grist mill, Stable & 6 or 7 acres cleared, and a family occupying this tract, the improvement is about 5 years old.*
