


The Ruston Surveys



Situate on Crosses Mill Run a Branch of Sandy Creek in Wharton township, Fayette County & Surveyed the 17th day of September 1835 in pursuance of a Warrant in the name of Charles Roe for 400^{acres} dated the 5th day of February 1794. there is a dwelling house, a Grist mill, Stable & 6 or 7 acres cleared, and a family occupying this tract, the improvement is about 5 years old.
