



In pursuance of an application bearing date April 3^d 1769 N^o:2472 surveyed on the 27th day of October 1788 unto John Robinson in right of Thomas M^cMullen Sen^r the above discribed tract of land situate on the waters of Sewickly-in Huntington township in the County of Westmoreland containing three hundred acres & $\frac{3}{4}$ of an acre and allowance of six pr. cent for roads &c.

NB the acres within the dotted lines is claimed by John Wood in pursuance of a warrant bearing date June 7th 1788 and returned with the above remark. Benj Lodge Woods' claim is dismissed by Order of Board of Property 2^d March 1790.
