



The above is a draught of a survey made the 24<sup>th</sup> day of December 1816 in pursuance of a warrant granted Matthias Roseberry bearing date the 10<sup>th</sup> day of March 1816 containing 101 acres and 104 perches and allowance of six per cent for roads &. Situate in Franklin township Greene County on M<sup>c</sup> Cortney's creek a branch of the South fork of Ten-mile creek called "Small Gap".
