



Draft of a tract of land situate in Gregg township Centre County containing thirty nine acres and one hundred twenty five perches & allowance of six percent for roads &c. surveyed the 17<sup>th</sup> day of June A.D. 1846 in pursuance of a warrant granted to David Rees dated the 9<sup>th</sup> day of April 1846 for 40 acres.

Note - The above survey is part of a tract of land surveyed for Peter Smith the 19<sup>th</sup> day of April AD. 1827 in pursuance of a warrant granted to Duncan M<sup>c</sup>Vicken dated the 7<sup>th</sup> day of December 1791 containing three hundred fifty acres and five perches and allowance &c.

The above tract of land was first improved in the Spring of 1825 - there are about 12 or 15 acres cleared and some apple trees planted, but no buildings of any kind.
