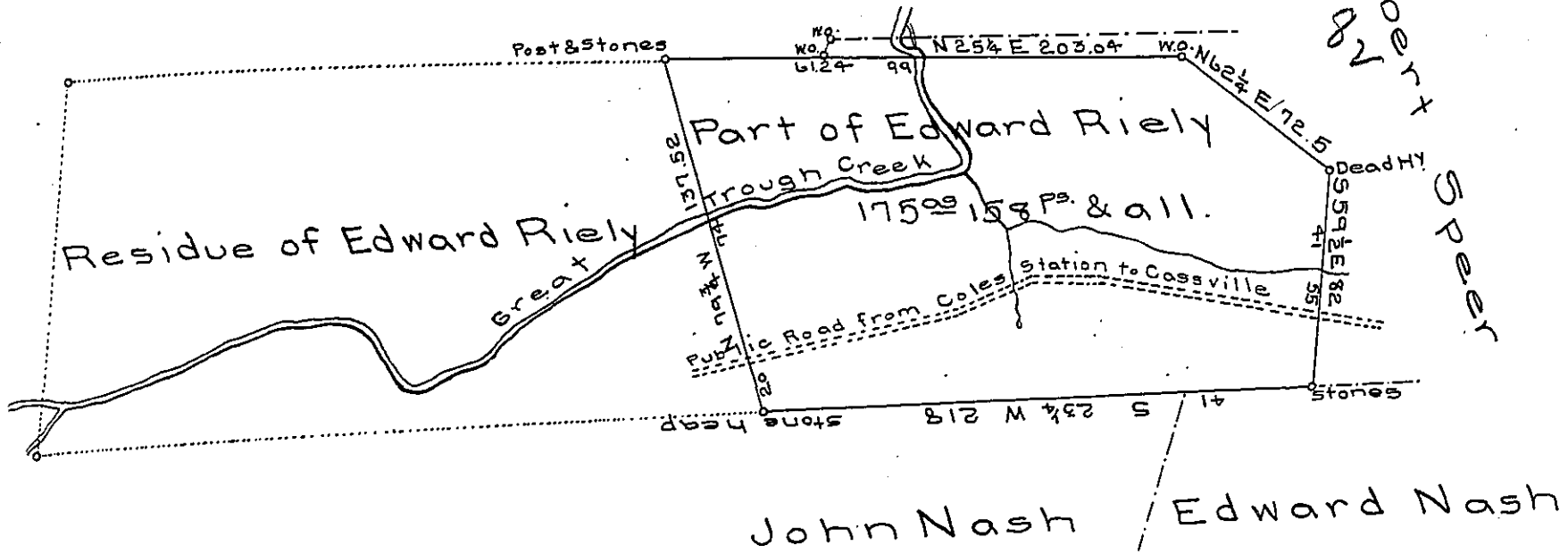

It being a part of a larger tract of three hundred seventy two acres 125<sup>ps.</sup> & allowance originally surveyed in pursuance of a warrant granted to Edward Riely dated the 23<sup>rd</sup> day of February A.D. 1785.
