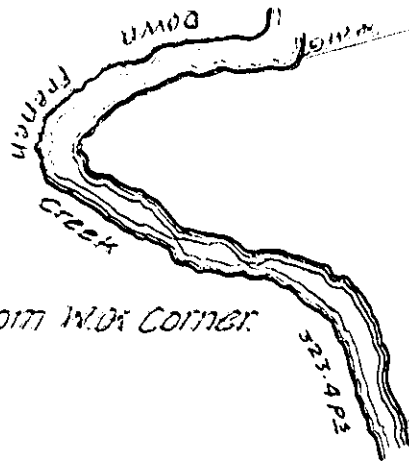

SITUATE on the East side of French Creek in Allegheny County  
Containing 373 Acres 102 perches and allowance of Six pr. Cent for  
Roads &c Resurveyed the 20<sup>th</sup> day of September 1797 In pursuance  
of a Warrant. Granted to John Wilkins dated the 18<sup>th</sup> day of March,  
1796 (It being the same tract of Land that was surveyed the 27<sup>th</sup>  
day of May 1794 to John Wentworth In pursuance of his Improvement  
bearing date the 3<sup>d</sup> day of April 1792.
