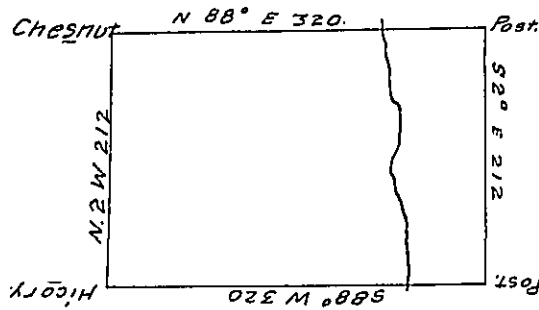

The above is a draught of a Survey made the 10<sup>th</sup> of June 1796 in pursuance of a Warrant granted James Wil-son on the 14<sup>th</sup> Aprile 1792 Situated on the waters of Big Beaver Creek in Alleghany County Containing four hundred Acres and allowance of Six per Cent Called "Cantwell."
