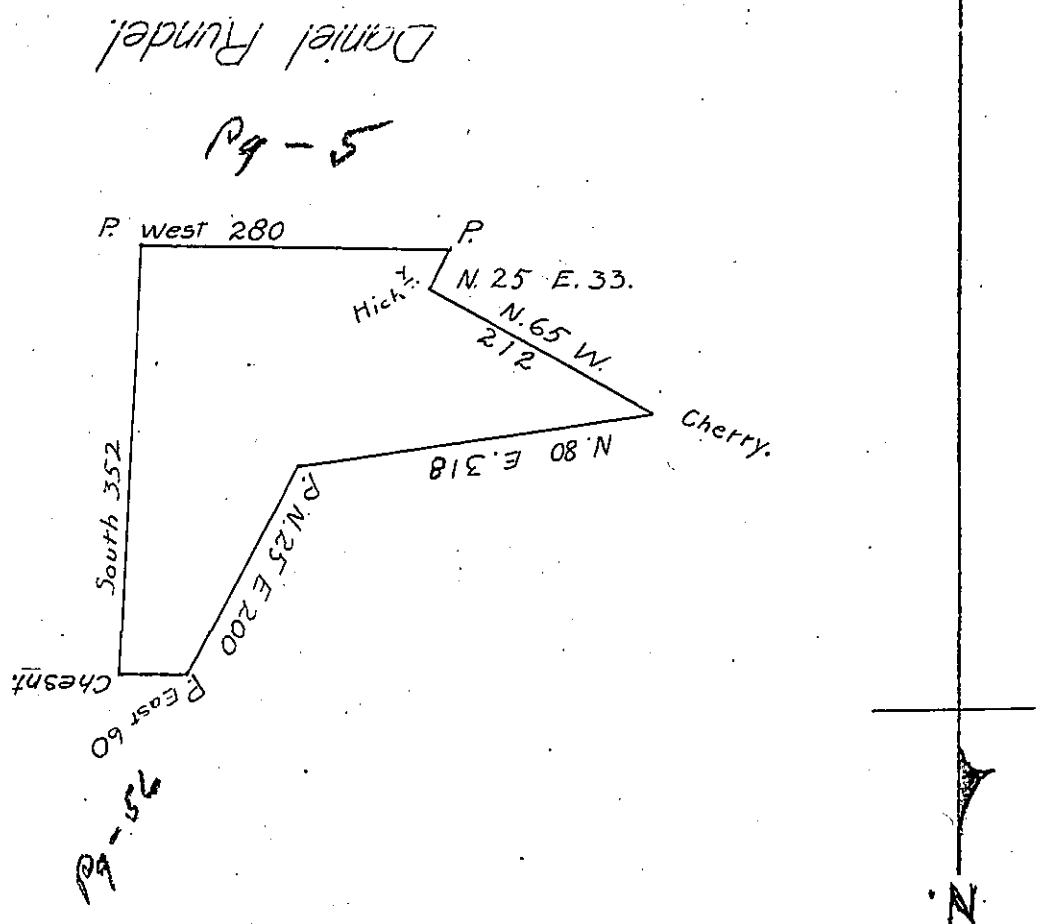

 acres and 144 perches with the usual allowance of 6 p^c Cent & c.
