



Survey'd the above described Island for John Piatt Esqr. on the 4th. day of October 1815 in persuance of his Warrant granted the 23d. day of August 1815 Containing three Acres & Seven perches Strict measure, Situate about ten perches from the South bank of West Branch of the River Susquehannah about half a mile from the Borough of Williamport opposite to Lands of Michael Ross or Abraham Grafus on the North side of the river and on the South Land now possessed by John Hughes in Washington Township Lycoming County.
