



Situate formerly in Newbury township but now in Fairview Township in the County of York, Containing as above set forth 4800 & 132 perches and Allowance. Being part of a larger Tract of 793 1/4 acs. and allowance, which was Originally Surveyed by Thomas Cookson late D.S. on the 18th day of May 1747, in pursuance of a Warrant for 5000 acs. granted to William Passmore bearing date the 1st day of December 1743. Resurveyed and divided off from the said larger Tract on the 3th day of March 1813, by Isaac Kirk D.S. under Jacob Spangler late D.S. and now at the request of James Powell the present owner I have calculated examined and found the same to be correct and return the Draught thereof for confirmation
