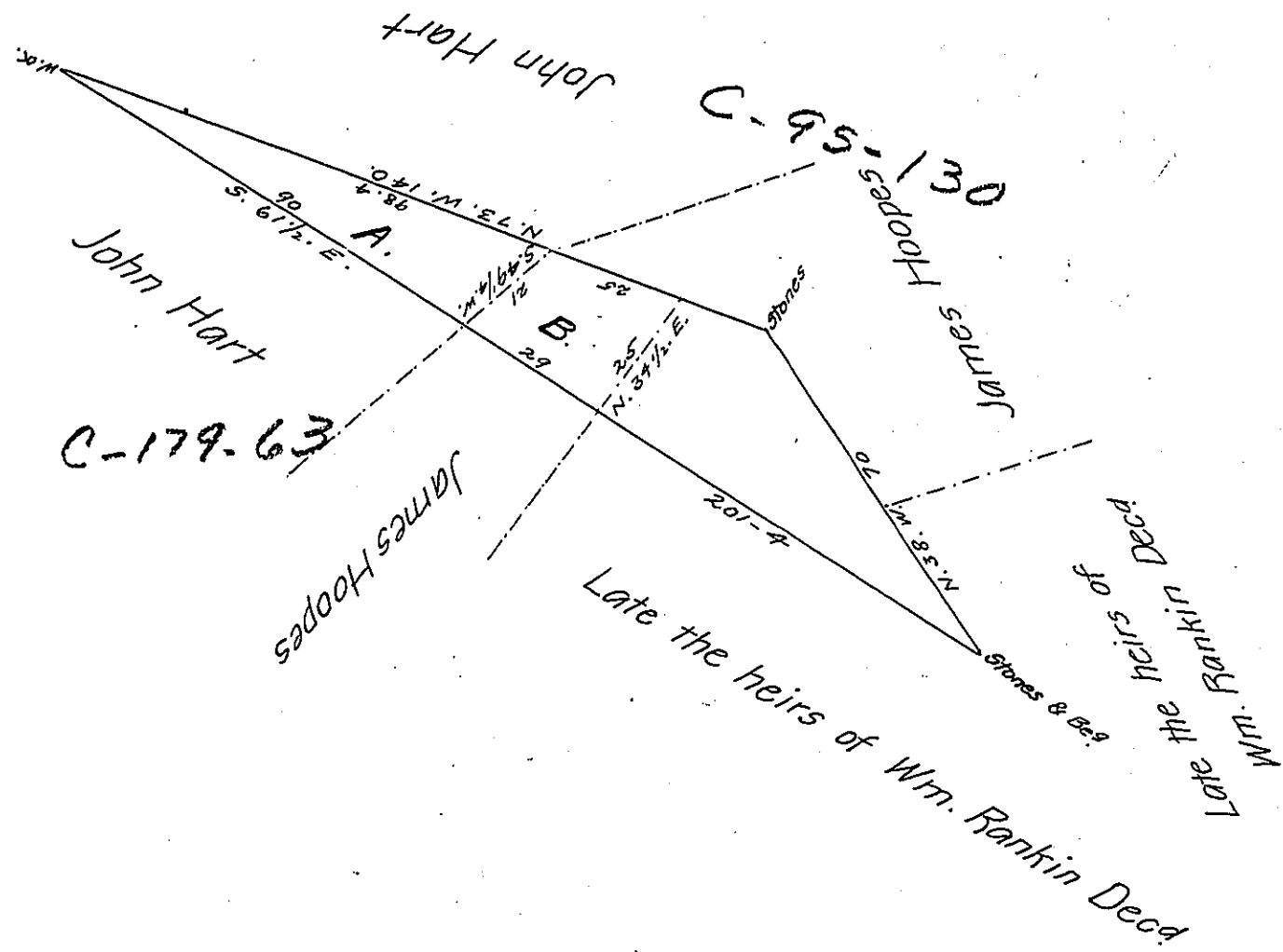

Situate in Newbury and Fairview Townships in the County of York, Containing as above set forth 169 & 94 perches and the usual allowance &c. Surveyed on the 28th. day of June A.D. 1814. In Pursuance of a Warrant granted to Nathan Potts for 18a. bearing date the 14th. day of June A.D. 1814 — N.B. The Improvements on the above described Land at the time of surveying were a Dwelling House Stable and a quany of Cleared Land, made with an evident intention of rendering it a place of abode and means of supporting a Family, and made prior to the 28th. day of March A.D. 1814 —

The part marked A, Containing 5a. & 9. perches and allowance is Claimed by John Hart, and the part marked with the letter B, Containing 3a. & 67 perches and allowance is claimed by James Hoopes both under a plea of some Improvements by Clearing Land and long Occupancy and ~~errors~~ exercising acts of ownership thereon, under an Impression that it was included in a Patent to Abraham Noblet dated the 21st. day of April 1760, which is now found to be excluded therefrom.
