in pursuance of the Application No. 4684, dated the 8th day of January 1768. Resur-  
veyed and divided off from the said larger Tract of Land the 31<sup>st</sup> day of May 1797  
and now at the instance of Fredrick Bupp the present owner the same has  
been calculated examined and found to be correct, and at his request I make  
return of the Draught for confirmation. April 11<sup>th</sup> 1821
