



In pursuance of a Warrant dated the 20th day of April 1770 I did Survey and lay out on the 21st day of April 1770 for Thomas Scattergood the above Described Lott of Ground Situate at or near the North End of the City of Philad<sup>a</sup> without the Limits thereof on the West side of Front Street Continued marked in a General Plan No.100 Containing in Breadth North and South on Front Street Continued 20 feet and in length East and West at the North side 106 feet and at the South side 105 feet. Bounded Eastward by Front Street Continued Southward by John Scattergoods Lott No.99. Westward by John Scattergoods lott No.103 & Northward by sd. Thomas Scattergoods Lott No.101.
