



In pursuance of a Warrant dated the 30th. day of March 1770 I did Survey and lay out on the 18th. day of April 1770 for John Scattergood the above described Lott of Ground at or near the North End of the City of Philad^a without the Limits thereof on the West side of Front Street Continued marked in a General Plan No. 99 Containing in Breadth North and South on Front Street Continued 20 feet and in length East and West at the North side 105 feet and at the South side 104 feet. Bounded Eastw^d by Front Street Continued Southward by sd. John Scattergood's Lott No. 98 Westward by said John Scattergood's Lott No. 103 and Northward by Thomas Scattergoods Lott No. 100.
