



A Draught of a Tract of Land situate in East Pennsboro Town-  
 ship in the County of Cumberland, part of the Honble the Proprietaries Manor  
 of Lowther in the Province of Pennsylvania formerly Surveyed by Col. John  
 Armstrong for a proprietary reserve in said Manor, But by His honour the  
 Governor's order to me directed, bearing date the 13th. of May 1767, I did re-  
 survey the same on the 28th. and 29th. days of the same Month and found  
 it to contain Five hundred and thirty ~~two~~ acres and allowance of Six  
 acres pCent for Roads &c.
