



A Draught of a Tract of Land Situate at Tulpehocken in Berks County Containing Two hundred and Twelve acres and Ten perches & allowance of 6 pCent being part of a Strip of Land cut off from the Honble Richard Penns Manor and Numbred in a General Plan of the same No. 11.

Returned into the Secretarys Office the 8th day of November 1771 for John Snevely by Warrant dated the 29th. October 1771.
