



A Draught of a tract of Land Situate in York township York County being part of a Larger tract of Land formerly Surveyed pr. George Smith for a Certain Michael Walleck in pursuance of a grant from Thomas Penn Esqr. for 250a. within the Manor of Springetsbury which said tract of Land and grant was by the said Walleck assigned to Henry Spangler and one Hundred and forty four acres and Land of said Grant Conveyed by the said Henry Spangler to his Son Rudolph Spangler and by his Executors to James Smith and Michael Swope Esqr^s and at the request of said Henry Spangler the whole tract was run round and their part Divided off and the above is the Draught of the remainder of the original tract. Surveyed the 14th. day of the 5th. mo. 1764.
