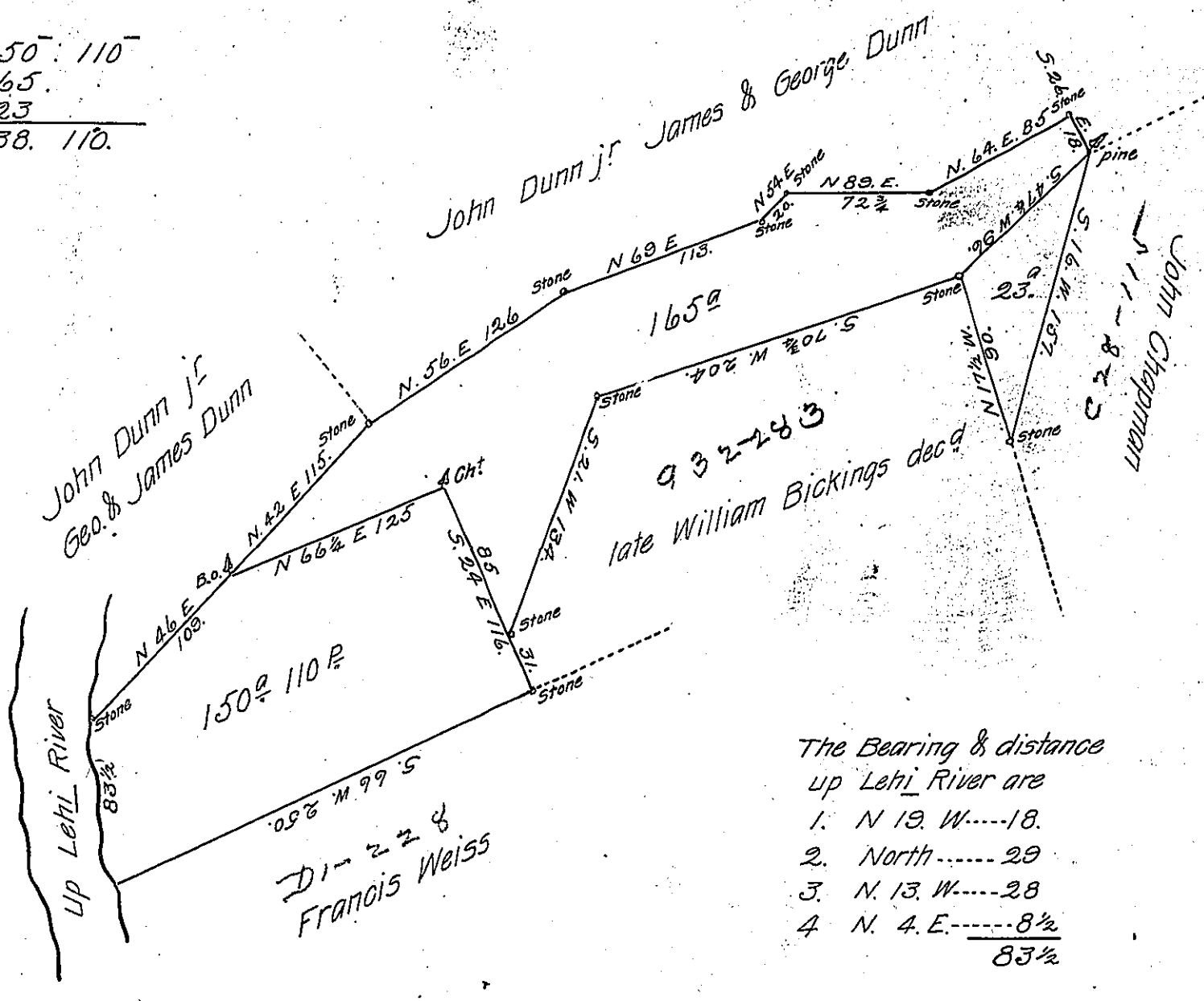

Cent & C. & C.

N.B. The piece marked 165<sup>a</sup> was Returned for Jacob David the 25 May 1789 with a Note it was Claimed by this Warrant.
