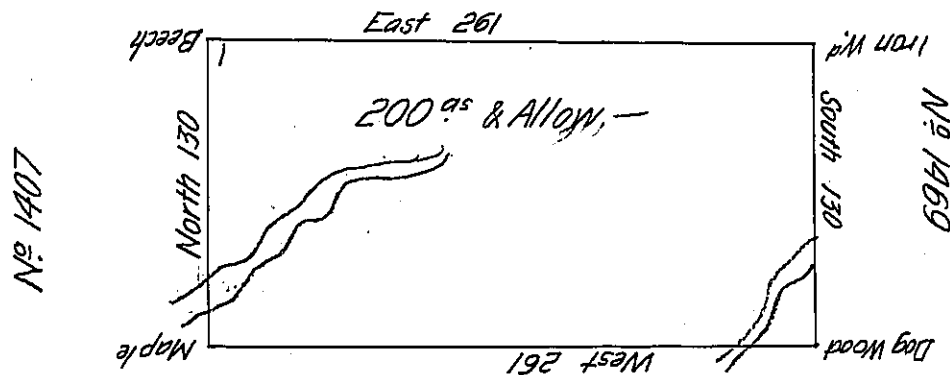

N<sup>o</sup> MCCCCLXXVIII situate in Dis<sup>t</sup> N<sup>o</sup> 7 on the west side of the Alleg<sup>y</sup> River in the County of Westmorland
