



A Draught of sixty acres and one hundred and sixteen perches of land with six per Cent for roads situate in Union township in Mifflin county surveyed 16th September 1811 in pursuance of a warrant to George Swartzel dated 3^d June 1802

Note this land is returned, by Draught, into the Surveyor General's Office in pursuance of an order of survey to Michael Knight dated 24th November 1766 numbered 1952 said to contain 54^a & 138 perches with usual allowance; but which has been adjudged to the said Warrant of him the said George Swartzel by Court and jury of men held in Lewistown in & for the said County of Mifflin first-June 1810. Improvement, is, about 8 acres cleared land, under fence, & in a state-cultivation.
