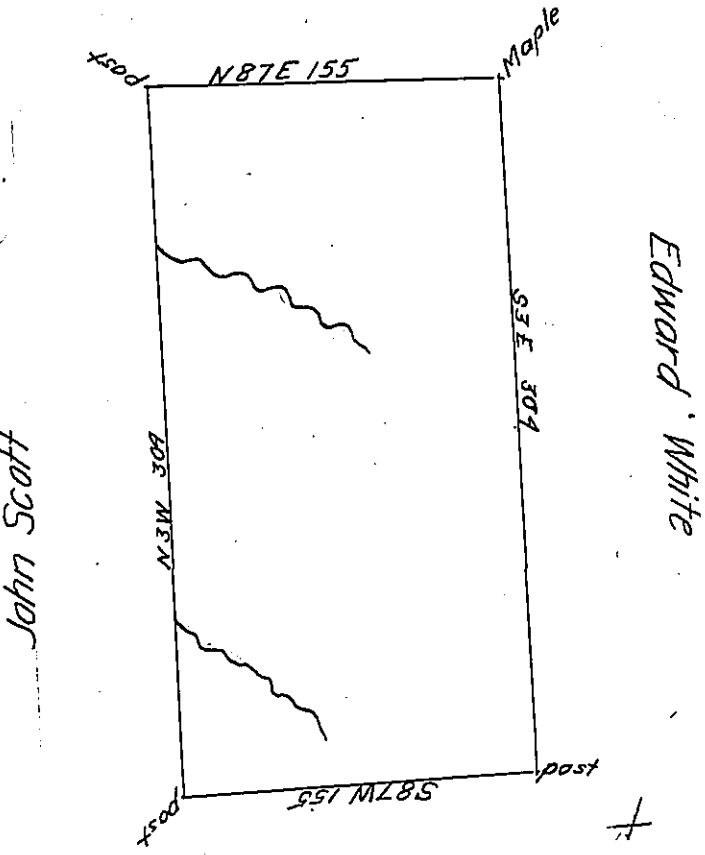


James Stewart

In pursuance of a Warrant Granted to William Scott, dated the 7th day of January 1811, Situate in Sherango Township, Beaver County, adjoining lands, of John Scott, James Stewart, and others, Containing 277 Acres & 132 perches and allowance of Six per Cent.
