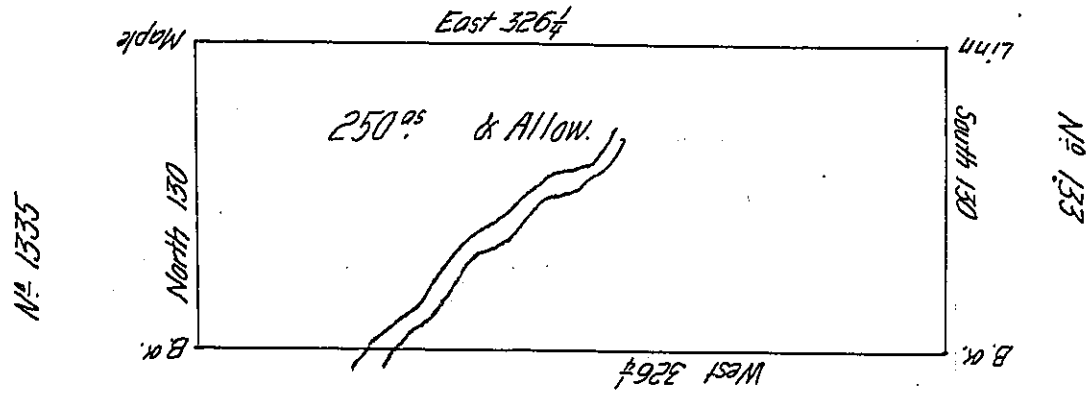

Assembly of the state of Penns.<sup>a</sup> Passed the 24<sup>th</sup> day of Febuary 1785 Intitled "an act for Directing the mode of Distributing the Donation Lands promised to the f. troops Of this Commonwealth & by order of the surveyor Gen<sup>l</sup> With the Approbation of the Hon<sup>l</sup>. the Executive Council I have surveyed on the 25<sup>th</sup> day of July 1785 - the Above Described tract of two Hund. & fifty Acres & Allow. of 6 P. Cent for roads &c. N<sup>o</sup>. CXXXIII situate in Dist N<sup>o</sup>. 7 on the west side of the Alleg<sup>y</sup> River in the County of Westmorland.
