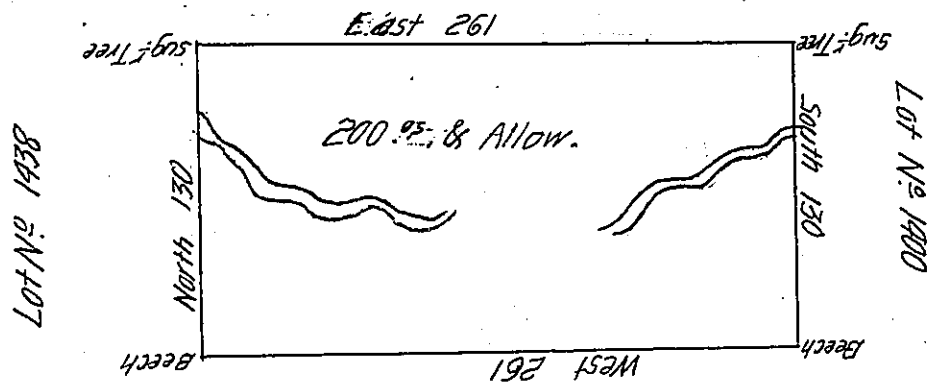

Promised to the troops of this Commonwealth & by order of the surveyor General With the Approbation of the Hon<sup>l</sup>. the Executive Council. I have surveyed on the 17<sup>th</sup> day of Aug<sup>t</sup> 1785 the Above described tract of two Hundred Acres & Allow. of 6 P.C<sup>t</sup> for Roads &c. No<sup>o</sup>. MCCCCXXXIII situate in District No<sup>o</sup>. 7 on the west side of the Allegeny River In the County of Westmarland.
