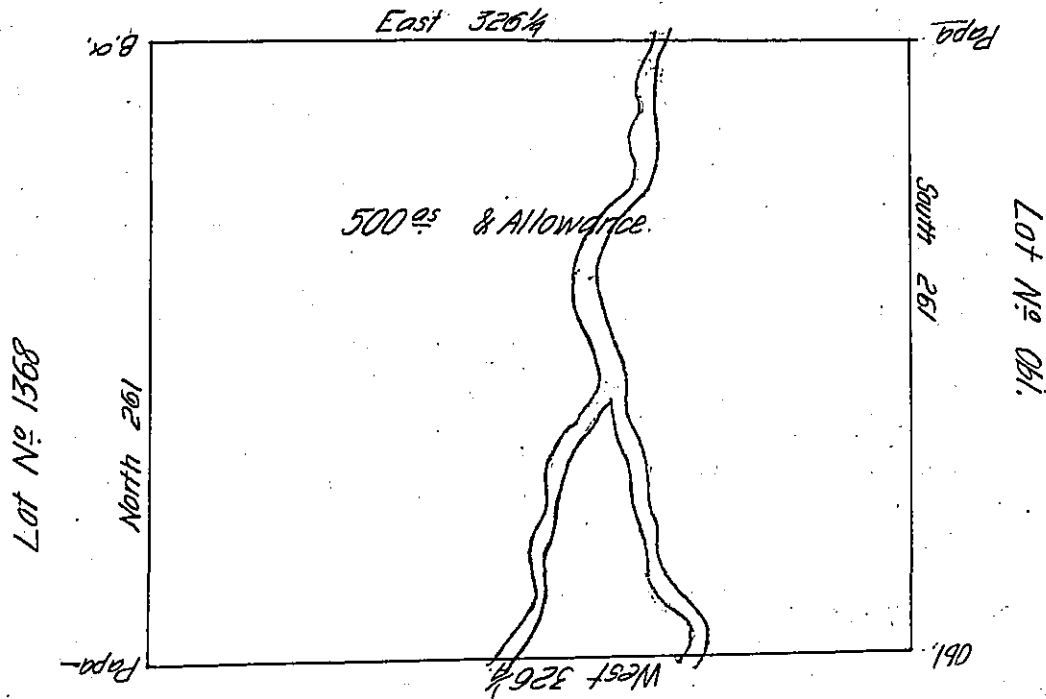

 tion of the Hon<sup>l</sup> the Executive Council I have surveyed On the 21<sup>st</sup> day of July 1785 the Above Des-  
 cribed tract of five Hundred Acres & Allow. of 6 P. Cent for Roads &c. N<sup>o</sup> CXXIV situate in District N<sup>o</sup> 7 on the  
 West side of the Allegeny River In the County Of Westmarland.
