A draught of a tract of land, Situate in Upper Milford Township in the County of Northampton, (formerly Bucks) and Province of Pennsylvania, Containing one hundred and forty six acres and 55 perches of land together with the usual allowance at six per cent for roads. That was formerly surveyed by Edward Scull unto John Shlyter (al Shlyfer) in pursuance of a warrant granted unto him by the Hon^{ble} Proprietaries, dated the 6th day of February Anno Domini 1744.

Resurveyed by order of the Surveyor General on the 19th day of June. Anno. 1765.

The said land doth now belong to Jacob Huber.
