



Situate on the waters of Raystown Branch of Juniatta — in Hope-
well, — now Broadtop township Bedford County Containing as
resurveyed four hundred and sixty nine acres forty two perches and
allowance of six per cent for roads &c. Originally surveyed the 29th
day of June 1794 on warrant dated the 1st day of March 1794 grant-
ed to Margaret Montgomery &c. &c.

The lines carefully reexamined upon the ground in June and
July 1853 and 1854 according to the Original marks. &c.

And again reexamined the 9th February 1855 in pursuance of
an order of resurvey granted by the Board of Property to Alexander
King Esqr. one of the executors of John King late of Bedford County
deceased. Bearing date the 9th day of August 1854. Courses accord-
ing to the true bearings
