



Situate in Windsor Township in the County of York, containing as above set forth 65^a & 135 perches & all^{cs}. Being part of a larger tract of 80^a & 91 perches & allowance &c. of land which was originally surveyed by William Kersey late D.S. on the 17th of the 10th month 1787. In pursuance of a warrant, granted to Joseph Liqett bearing date the 9th day of January 1786. which said original survey had included land held by adverse or older titles. Resurveyed & divided off from the said larger tract excluding the surveys of prior date and correcting the Errors, the 20th day of October A. D. 1810, at the request of the owner Charles Diehl who desired the same to be returned for confirmation.
