



In pursuance of an order of resurvey dated February 5th 1800 Directed to Sam^l: Lyon Esq Altho never given into his hands I being insisted upon by the heirs of Stewart to execute the order I here transmit to you as exact a draught as I can agreeable to all the information I can get. Having been on the ground and examined the lines I find the resurvey made by Mr. Lyon datobliterated 14th 1792 to be accurate and it appears that the warrant of William Stewart dated October 29th 1765 was laid on the land that Stewarts heirs says it was Having run all the lines I find the courses nearly to agree with that of Hendersons. But not the distances also found line trees and block^d them the agree with the date of the survey made by Henderson having Block^d a B. ok marked thus # on the line S 22 1/2 E 59 1/2 also a W. ok Corner marked thus → and also agrees as to making report of all the information that can derived from the books and papers in the hands of the late deputy I am depriv^d. But I here inclose you an exact copy of a draught Copy^d from the field notes of Mathew Hen-
