



Situate on the East side of the Raystown Branch of Juniatta in Hopewell — now Broadtop township Bedford County Containing according to resurvey four hundred and sixty three acres fifty five perches and allowance of six per cent for roads &c. Originally surveyed the 29th day of June 1794 on warrant dated the 1st day of March 1794 granted to John Montgomery. &c.

The lines carefully reexamined upon the ground in June & July 1853 & 1854 according to the original marks.

And again reexamined the 12th day of March A.D. 1855 in pursuance of an order of Resurvey granted by the Board of Property to Alexander King Esq^r one of the executors of John King late of Bedford County Deceased. Bearing date the 9th day of August A.D. 1854. Courses according to the true bearing.
