



A Plan of a Lot of Ground situate on the west side of George Street and south side of Philadelphia Street in the town of York marked on the general Plan of the said Town Number 65 containing in breadth on George street aforesaid fifty seven feet and six Inches and in length along Philadelphia Street to a twenty Feet Alley two hundred and fifty feet Bounded eastward with George Street aforesaid. Southward with a Lot of ground marked on the Plan aforesaid No 66. Westward with a twenty feet alley and Northward with Philadelphia ^{street} aforesaid which said lot of ground I have purchased & surveyed & laid out for my self and have built an house on the same according to the conditions of settling the town. Certified at York the 15th day of March 1762.
