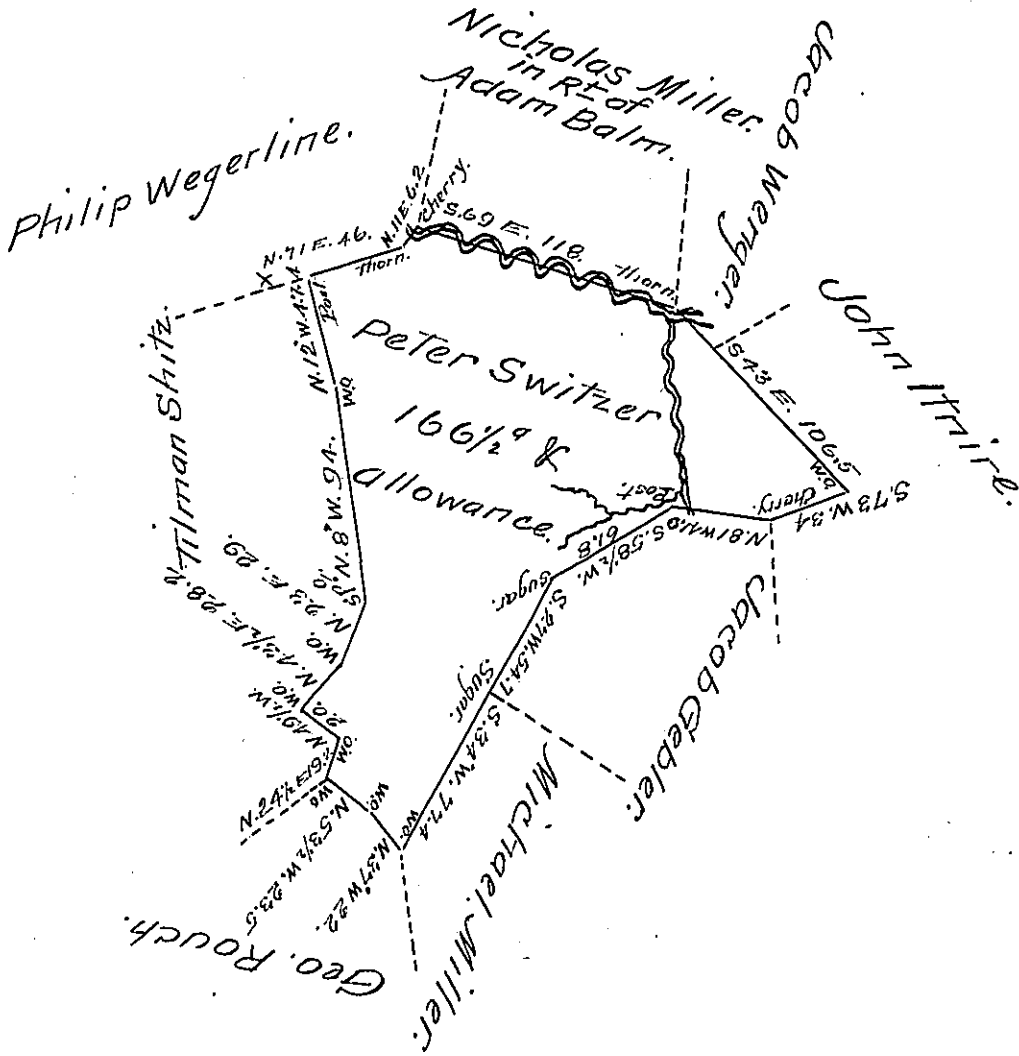


Note this survey is Entered in Alexander McClean's former Record Book and probably returned. But for fear of a dis-appointment to the Owner send this -

In pursuance of a Warrant Granted unto Peter Switzer dated the 5th day of October 1784. Certified the 26th September 1805
