



A Draught of Two hundred and ninety seven acres and 20 perches and the allowance of Six <sup>ths</sup> Cent for roads &c. Being Part of a larger Tract of Land situate in Fermanagh Township (former-Cumberland) now Mifflin County which appears Survey'd for Valentine Sterne the 31<sup>st</sup> day of August 1761 and said to Contain 535 1/4 acres and the allow<sup>ce</sup> &c. In pursuance of the Honorable the Proprietaries Warrants, one in the name of Valentine Sterne - and one in the name of James Patterson for 150 acres Each Bearing ~~the~~ Date the 6<sup>th</sup> day of Feb<sup>y</sup> 1755.

April 23<sup>d</sup> 1805 - The above part laid off agreeable to lines said to have been formerly made by the Heirs of Valentine Sterne Deceased.
