



The above Draught includes a Survey of 184^{ac} & allowance made the 14th of the 10th mo. 1743. In Pursuance of a warrant Granted to John Pig-gott, bearing Date the 1st day of March 1737, the Right of which passed thro' Sundry Hands, and at length was purchased by Richard Sted-man, who obtained a warrant bearing Date the 16th of August 1749 to include some vacancies adjoining the said Former Survey, in Pursuance whereof the Quantity of 7.2^{ac} & allowance was added, making in the whole 256^{ac} & allowance as above ~~certify~~ mentioned-
