We the Commissioners for adjusting Claims to Unpatented Lands in the Countys of Yohogania Monongalea and Ohio Do hereby Certifie that Moses Smith is intitled to One Hundred and Fifty Acres of Land in the County of Yohogania, on the East side of the River Yohogania, on the So. West side of Stevensons run adjoining the lands Claimed by Philip Mason William Mason Ezek' Heckman and Ralph Cherry to include his settlement made in the Year One Thousand Seven Hundre and sixty Eight Given under Our Hands at Redstone Old Fort This 5th day of Jan^y 1780, and in the fourth Year of the Commonwealt^h.
