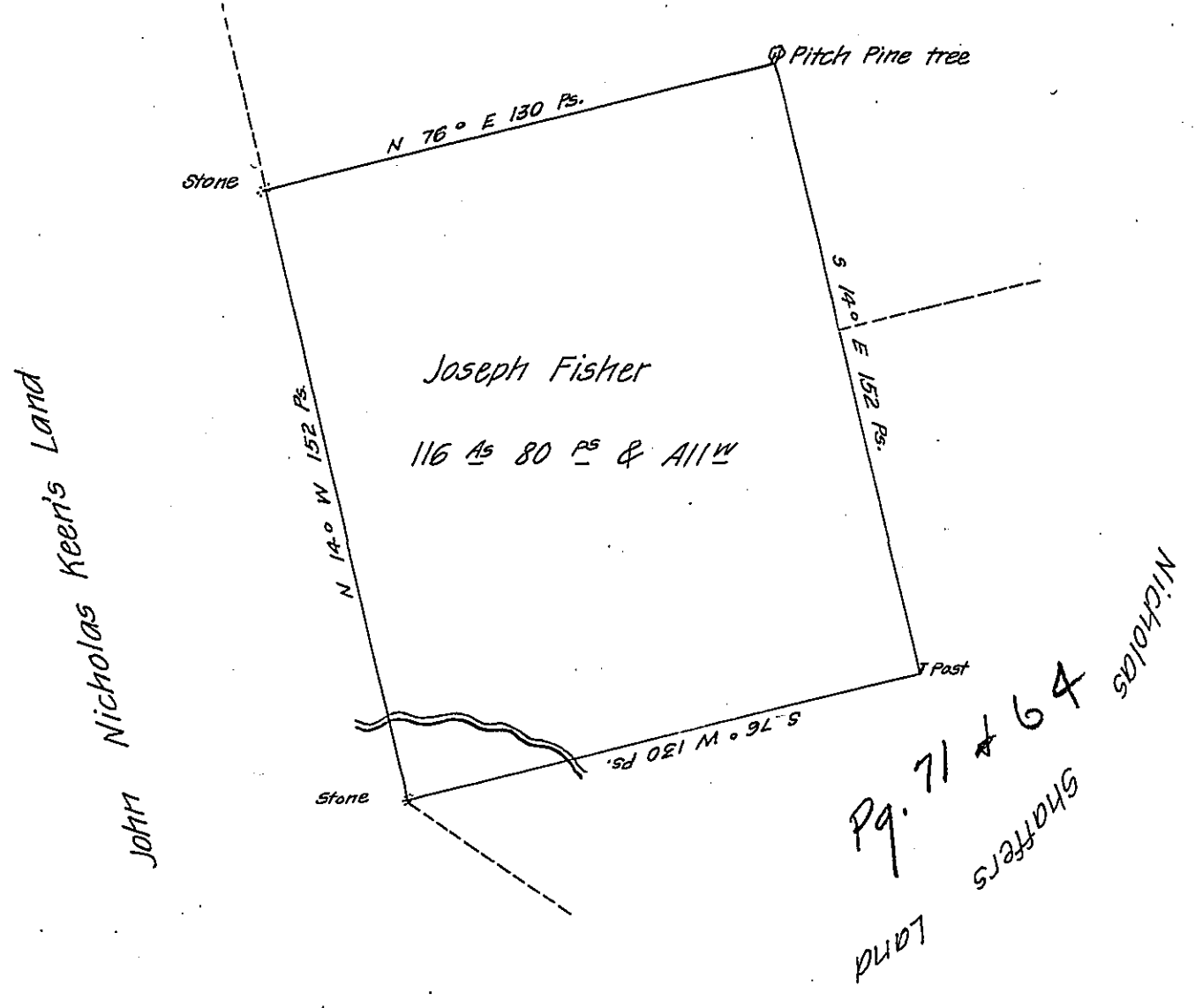

Draught of a Tract of Land Situate in Brunswick Township in the County of Berks Surveyed by Henry Vanderslice deceased late Deputy Surveyor of Berks County aforesaid on the 28th day of March A.D. 1777 unto Joseph Fisher in pursuance of a Warrant bearing date the 8th day of November A.D. 1776 Containing one hundred and sixteen Acres eighty perches and Allowance of six Per Ct. for Roads &c^g.
