Situate on the heads of the South <sup>West</sup> Branch of Stony Creek in Brothers Valley Township - Now Somerset County and Surveyed the 17<sup>th</sup> day September 1774 by Alexander McClean Esquire late D.S. as appears from his Official Draught remaining in my office in pursuance of a Warrant granted unto Casper Shrack for 160<sup>ac</sup> bearing date the 20<sup>th</sup> day of December 1773 And Certified the 16<sup>th</sup> day of -1804
