



Surveyed on the third day of March 1733 to Peter Andreas a tract of land situate in Safford Township in the County of Philad^a Beginning at a Corner post of Andreas Switzer's Land thence by the same South West one hundred & sixty eight perches to a post thence by Vacant Land south east eighty eight perches to a Spanish Oak a corner of Michael Boots land thence by the same North sixty degrees East Sixty two perches to a Black Oak Saplin thence by the said Boots land North East one hundred & Eight perches to a post in the line of Christopher Duck's land thence by the same North West one hundred & four perches to y^e place of Beginning containing one hundred acres with usual allowance
